



# WATER PARK POOL RULES

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## PERSONAL CONDUCT

- All Aquatic Center users MUST SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING the pool area
- SWIMSUITS ONLY. No leotards, cut-offs, denim, cotton, t-shirts
- Children who are not toilet trained MUST WEAR SWIM DIAPERS
- Please no spitting, spouting of water or blowing the nose in the water
- Boisterous or rough play is not allowed
- NO RUNNING
- Persons violating personal conduct regulations, written or verbal, may be subject to disciplinary action or asked to leave without a refund
- All other state and local health laws apply

## CHILDREN SUPERVISION

- Swimmers must be 14 or older to use the pool without adult supervision
- Swimmers between the ages of 11-13 must have an adult in the aquatic area supervising them at all times.  
The supervising adult must be in the same pool
- Swimmers 10& Under must have an adult physically in the water with them in order to swim.
- Children 3 and under must be accompanied in the pool by an adult in arm's reach
- Parents or guardians must be responsible for supervising their children
- Lifeguards are on duty only to enforce rules and to respond in case of an emergency

## PLAY TOYS & FLOTATION DEVICES

- The only balls allowed in the Aquatic Areas are water balls.
- No flotation devices are allowed: noodles, tubes, etc.
- ONLY Coast Guard approved Personal Flotation Devices are allowed in the pool
- Swimsuits with flotations and water wings are not allowed

## FOOD/BEVERAGES

- Food may not be brought into the water
- Eating and drinking are permitted only on the tables
- Please throw garbage into the trash containers

## FEATURES/PLAY AREAS

- **Current Channel**
  - No age requirement
  - Artificial Current; Strong swimmers only
  - Lifeguards have the right to not allow swimmer into the current during that swim visit unless completely accompanied by an adult.
- **Lap Lanes**
  - At no time is play swimming allowed in the lap lanes. Lap Swimming, Aerobic Aqua Walking and scheduled programming are all that is allowed to occur in the lap lanes
  - May need to share during busy times
- Aquatic attractions such as the waterslide and play fort feature are only allowed to be played on when these attractions are turned on.
- The toddler slide located in the zero depth by the current channel is allowed to be used by toddlers at any time as long as the parent is in the water with them providing assistance
- **Waterslide**
  - One person at a time please wait for attendant to say GO
  - Must be 42" tall
  - Feet first
  - Must swim to stairs when they have reached the bottom of the slide
  - No intentionally stopping or spinning on the slide
- **Play Fort**
  - No more than one rider on the slide
  - Feet first
  - Exit the bottom of the slide immediately
  - Do not climb up the sides or the slide
  - No jumping off the stairs
- **Toddler Slide**
  - No more than two swimmers on the slide at a time
  - Sitting, feet first
  - No climbing up the slide
- **Private Lessons**
  - Private Lessons may only be conducted by authorized RecPlex staff

## SAFETY

- Chewing gum, tobacco, food, drink are not allowed in the pool area
- Glass & shatterable plastic items are not permitted in the pool area
- No smoking or vaping in the RecPlex
- Do not enter the pool if you have communicable disease or an open cut
- Do not bring animals into the pool area
- **Rules may be added or waived by the management when appropriate**
